AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 28 TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES SECTION 6 SPEED LIMIT OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF BRIARCLIFFE ACRES, SOUTH CAROLINA TO AMEND PROVISIONS REGARDING SPEED LIMITS WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the Town of Briarcliffe Acres Code Chapter 28 Traffic and Motor Vehicles needs to be amended to better reflect the safety concerns within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Briarcliffe Acres Council believes it is in the best interest of the town to amend this ordinance;

NOW THEREFORE by the power and authority granted to the Town of Briarcliffe Acres by the Constitution of the State of South Carolina and the powers granted to the Town by the General Assembly of the State, it is ordained and enacted:

1. **That the Code of the Town of Briarcliffe Acres, South Carolina, is hereby amended to read as follows:**

ADDITIONS ARE UNDERLINED AND DELETIONS ARE SHOWN AS ~~STRIKE-THRU~~:

Sec 28-3. –Speed Limit

It shall be unlawful to drive a motor vehicle at speeds exceeding 25 mph on the roads, **unless otherwise posted,** in the Town of Briarcliffe Acres, except that the maximum speeds on U.S. Highway 17 within town limits are not regulated by this chapter.

2. **Severability:** If a Section, Sub-section, or part of this Ordinance shall be deemed or found to conflict with a provision of South Carolina law, or other pre-emptive legal principle, then that Section, Sub-section, or part of this Ordinance shall be deemed ineffective, but the remaining parts of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
3. **Conflict with Preceding Ordinances:** If a Section, Sub-section or provision of this Ordinance shall conflict with the provisions of a Section, Sub-section or part of a preceding Ordinance of the Town of Briarcliffe Acres, then the preceding Section, Sub-section, or part shall be deemed repealed and no longer in effect.
4. **Effective Date:** This Ordinance shall become effective on Second Reading.

AND IT IS SO ORDAINED, ENACTED AND ORDERED.
