

On Monday, May 2, 2022, at 5:00pm, the Town Council held a Budget Workshop at the Town Hall located at 121 North Gate Road, Myrtle Beach, South Carolina 29572.

The media and public were duly notified of the date, time, and place of the Workshop. At 5:00pm, with a quorum present, Mayor Buonviri called the Budget Workshop to order.

Mayor Buonviri began the Workshop with a quick overview of the Agenda.

Budget discussions followed, beginning with Mayor Tempore Bell:

Mayor Tempore Bell: Budget - In preparation for Fiscal Year 2022 – 2023, she prepared and provided a new, working document with budget details. First reading of the new budget ordinance will take place at the May Town Meeting. She is still waiting for correspondence from Horry County about **property and vehicle taxes**.

Roads – Since the roads fees from the County are still in question, there will be no line item and the budget may be amended at a later date.

Councilwoman Pendley: Proposed establishing an expense and income account number for **donations**, etc.

ARP: This will encompass **Lakes Maintenance**, **Stormwater Drainage projects**, and **Roads** funding for the upcoming fiscal year. Residuals must be projected by 2024 and exhausted by 2026, with the second tranche expected in November.

All **income** and **expense** items were projected and will be adjusted accordingly through the end of the fiscal year. Necessary additions, deletions, and changes will also be made prior to the Title Only reading in May.

A new **Agenda item** including specific topics, ordinances, or areas requiring attention will be added on an as needed basis. Items from the discussions were added to the Budget Meeting Agenda.

No Public Input was shared during the session.

The Mayor requested that the Clerk send a reminder to residents that time has expired for placing Fire Wise debris by the road. Chief Lamparter suggested that the split rail fences be replaced in front of the Cabana and at the south entrance to the Beach after hurricane season; Mayor Buonviri agreed to make the request at the Association Annual Meeting as they are charged with their maintenance and/or replacement.

The dates and times of upcoming Meetings were announced, and at 6:11pm, with no further business to discuss, the Budget Workshop adjourned.
