

On Monday, February 7, 2022, at 5:00pm, the Town Council held a Council Workshop at the Town Hall located at 121 North Gate Road, Myrtle Beach, South Carolina 29572.

The media and public were duly notified of the date, time, and place of the Workshop. At 5:00pm, with a quorum present, Mayor Buonviri called the Workshop to order.

Mayor Buonviri began the Workshop with a quick overview of the Agenda.

## **Discussions** followed, beginning with the Mayor:

**Mayor Buonviri: Stormwater and Lakes** – The Mayor has a preliminary Lakes meeting set with Richard Black of Total Lake Care, Chelsea Cogliano, Horry County Watershed Planner, and other Horry County officials to discuss and preview Total Lakes' assessment of the Lakes and the use of American Rescue Fund (ARP) funding in the efforts. Black will be invited (rescheduled) to provide findings, results, and recommendations to Council and residents at the Town Meeting. Mayor Buonviri will also be meeting with a local surveyor about areas of opportunity for drainage grades.

**Mayor Tempore Bell: Town Hall Lawn Beautification Project** – The Mayor Pro Tem provided Council with an up-to-date budget for the project. She also reported on the hardscaping, the flagpole arrival and installation, bush hogging, and irrigation completion. She and Councilwoman Pendley will send a progress email to Town residents.

**Councilman Palliser: Roads** – The Councilman plans to provide a roads repair update in the upcoming weeks and requested trouble areas be reported to him. He addressed construction vehicles entering the Town and damages to the roads; in the future, contractors will be notified for repairs.

**Docks** - Palliser is ready to convene communication with dock owners in reference to repairs and required insurance.

**Councilwoman Pendley: Technology/Communication** – She reported that the Town has a permanent, Target Manager with VC3 and that in two weeks, a risk assessment should be complete.

**Councilman Wylie and Clerk: Fire Wise -** April 23 is established for Public Safety and Fire Wise Awareness day at the Town Hall. The event will be announced to residents later. The debris collection will begin on April 26, a week after the canopy and right of way trimming.

Chief Lamparter: Ordinance regulating ocean-front fences and residential signage - The Chief reviewed legal council's changes, and the Mayor requested that Council provide any recommendations by the following Monday so that a new draft may be ready for the Town Meeting. The Clerk will request the Horry County Code for pool enclosures for comparison

**Public Input** about rocks, cones, signs, and fences was shared during the session.

The date and time of the next Meeting was announced, and at 6:05pm, with no further business to discuss, the Council Workshop adjourned.
